| Full Board: 3 meals per day | Typically students will prepare their own breakfast & lunch and host prepares dinner. The full board program is required for all Minors under 19. |
| Half Board: breakfast and dinner | Breakfast is typical breakfast items in regular portions such as: cereal, toast, juice, coffee, bagel, eggs, fruit or yogurt. Half board does not include taking food or snacks from the home to consume at school or while out. |
| Room Stay: no meals | LIMITED AVAILABILITY. Access to kitchen and refrigerator storage shelves and cooking facilities are expected for foods students purchase and prepare for themselves. Students are responsible for cleaning the kitchen after use. |
| B&B: breakfast only | LIMITED AVAILABILITY. As with Half Board, without dinner. |

CHN's refund policy will apply to cancellations.

Note: The Excise Tax Act defines which services and homestay host allowances attract GST or HST. Canada Homestay Network Society is registered to collect and remit GST/HST on certain services, including, but not limited to, (a) Registration, Placement and Orientation fee provided to students registered after their arrival in Canada; (b) Airport transfers; (c) Daily host transportation allowances; and (d) Daily host allowances for students staying in homestay for less than one month.
